Clarence "Stan" Jordan, 78 years of age, went home to our Lord on February 8, 2025.

He is survived by his wife Rebecca Emery, his Aunt Clara Bond of Georgia, and his two children Kenneth Jordan, wife Kim Jordan, and Jeffrey Scott Jordan, from a previous marriage. He also leaves behind two stepchildren. His family includes fourteen grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Oscar Clarence Jordan, and Dorothy L. Jordan.

He graduated from Northeast Georgia Police Academy and attended the University of Georgia Center. Graduate of Athens High School, class of 1964.

Clarence is a four-year veteran of the U.S. Air Force. Clarence served as a helicopter crew member, supporting missions for the President of the United States, during the Vietnam War. Following his distinguished military service, Clarence dedicated several years to his community as a police officer and investigator with the Clarke County Police Department. Years later, he also worked for The Millard Group based out of Chicago, ILL. In his last few years, Officer Jordan worked as a Security Officer for Eastern Florida State College.

Clarence, formerly known as Stan Jordan, enjoyed country and gospel music,

dancing, and in his earlier years was an active member of the Optimist Club. He was also selected as one of the Outstanding Young Men of America by the United States Jaycees in 1977.

Clarence was a devoted family man and a man of faith and belonged to St. Gabriel's Episcopal Church of Titusville. Stan will be deeply missed by family and friends.
