Donald served honorably in the U.S. Navy, during the Korean War aboard the USS Orion, as a Diesel Engineman Third Class. He was a carpenter by trade and worked as a foreman with Chicago Bridge and Iron (CBI) during the construction of the Vertical Assembly Building at Kennedy Space Center in the 1960's. He later went on to work for Pan American World Airways, then Johnson Controls at Cape Canaveral Air Station and retired in 1999. He spent his retirement years doing what he treasured most, traveling and spending time with his beloved family.

Donald became a devoted follower of Christ in 1963. He faithfully served the Christ he loved and served in many capacities, as well as a Deacon at Clearlake Baptist for over 40 years.
