When the lady met him at the door in nothing more than a sheet, pops wasn't sure if it was a good sign, or a sign of the whirlwind that would ensue for the next 18 years.

Pops stayed very busy brighten many people's days, while occasionally sneaking in a stop here and there at the local dinners to indulge upon a piece of homemade peanut butter pie and coffee. Notably these stops were not sanctioned by grandma.

There was a few snafoos along the way, like the time pops forgot to put the van in park when making a deliver, and he and the recipient had to chase down the van to stop it. Or the time that the wrong casket spray was delivered to the wrong service, and pops and grandma had to return to the church as the family was arriving to swap out the flower arrangements.

Or the Christmas that a client ordered a huge poinsettia tree, it barely fit in the delivery vehicle, it toppled over and pops had to work his Majic on the side of the road to piece it back together and make the delivery.

Or the many times that pops would go the extra mile to make the delivery to the recipient, often making several trips to assure that the recipient was home to receive their special delivery.

During our busy holidays, the WHOLE family and dear friends would always pitch in to help at the flower shop. Pops always loved that, he would joke around with them about showing up late, and having to “cut their pay” or how he drove all over town because the address they collected was wrong. But it was how we kept going, In those crazy times.

And then came Fridays!!! there was football. Every Friday nite you could find pops in the stands anticipating a viper win. He would show up an hour before the game, get the freshest grilled burger and dog, and wait for Kris and Heather to take the field. He was a dedicated fan, long after our kids graduated. When pops was unable to join in the crowded stands, the Space Coast athletic director made arrangements for pops to park in the bus loop, so that

*he could continue to enjoy the games.
And then there was Volleyball and basketball. Pops loved to watch Maiya's games. Although he wasn't able to attend every game, it did not lessen the love he had to watch her play. He would always ask how her spurts were going, and anticipated the next time he could watch her play.*

We can look back a chuckle at these memories, but in all reality, it's these memories that keep him close to our hearts in the days and years to follow. We miss you pops, until we see you again.

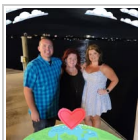
