The news of Jimmy's passing has hit me hard.

I hadn't seen him since probably 1986 maybe even 85.

I came of age in Rockledge having moved here to live with my mother.

I lived very near the corner of rockledge Ave and rockledge drive and my friend group was mostly a few years older than me.

I remember meeting Jim when he parked on the corner of rockledge Ave and Seminole near rockledge high School and I would see him every morning as I walked to school and I would stop and talk with him and others on that corner.

I will always remember him for his charismatic personality and an energy that seemed contagious.

I remember recognizing what I would describe as a kinship with him almost immediately.

Without a conscious thought about it, I knew that he was someone I could trust.

I did become friends with him and spent time hanging out with him and others.

There are many people that I have memories of from my formative years in Rockledge, but jim stands out as someone who befriended me and made me feel accepted.

I will always especially remember one afternoon when I was walking home down rockledge Ave towards the river when Jim pulled up beside me and invited me to jump into his ride and head to a YES concert at Lakeland Civic Center, I can't remember the circumstances, but he had an extra ticket and without a second thought he said he needed a copilot, someone to ride shotgun and navigate.. I remember that whole experience, the ride there, the concert, and the trip home for being just an amazing time, upbeat and fun throughout. I even remember being dropped off at home, being still hyped from the concert and excited to tell people about the whole experience.. I felt so fortunate to have gotten to see YES in concert and that Jimmy had made an adventure from start to finish..

I joined the Navy not long after that and lost touch with almost everyone I knew from Rockledge, but there have been many times when I have told my daughters and others stories of my experiences in Rockledge and Jim's is one of the names that comes up often.

When I moved back here late in 2025, I had planned to look him up and was unfortunately informed of his passing.

I will always remember him with fondness and joy in my heart.
