Jane Gaertner Stimson departed this life for her heavenly home 7/22/2017.

Born May 5, 1925 in Atlanta GA to Mr. & Mrs. Marion A. Gaertner. Jane attended Atlanta schools and Florida State College for Women in Tallahassee (now FSU) where she received a degree in Public School Music with a minor in Organ. Jane was a member of Covenant Presbyterian Church in Atlanta, GA. After graduation she returned to Atlanta and taught in the local school system and helped with the Atlanta Boys Choir.

Jane married Bailey E. Stimson August 30, 1947. They first met at age 16 at a Presbyterian youth conference at Maryville College in TN. After marriage they lived in Knoxville, TN until Bailey's graduation from University of Tennessee. Bailey was employed by the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) in Florence, AL where Jane had her first daughter, Irene. Next they moved to Memphis, TN where Jane had her second daughter, Joy.

Bailey transferred to the Army Ballistic Missile Agency (ABMA) and moved to Brevard County Fl.

Jane had twin boys Richard and William and a third daughter, Elizabeth. Jane had 6 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren.

Over the years Jane was active with many church and school organizations. She loved working with young people & children. Jane's last teaching position was 10 years in third grade at St. Mark's Episcopal Church School in Cocoa, FL.
