On April 6, 2017, Jesse passed away unexpectedly at his home, in Cocoa, Florida.

Jesse was born in Bonifay, Florida on September 24, 1936 and raised in Columbus, Georgia along with 5 sisters and brothers. He joined the U.S. Air Force in 1956 at the age of 20. Jesse met the love of his life, Nancy, in 1974 and they were married for 44 years.

After traveling the world, Jesse retired honorably from the Air Force as Chief Master Sgt. at Andrews Air Force Base in 1980. He accepted a job with Pan Am World Services, at Cape Canaveral Air Force Station, immediately after retiring from the Service. He worked for several contractors at Cape Canaveral and KSC before retiring yet again in 2004. He spent his retirement years doing what he loved most, traveling, fishing, motorcycle riding, taking cruises, and spending time with his beloved wife and family.
