Before Karen's 12 year successful floral business, Bloomers Floral of Cocoa Florida, she was a general contractor in the Brevard County area. Karen simultaneously ran her company East Point Construction. Her reputation for quality work was noted by her many awards and was ranked in the top third of construction companies in Florida by Buildzoom.

Karen was a force within the Florida Jaycees. She rose through the ranks earning many awards and accolades along the way. She reached her apex in 1999 when she served as the president for the Florida Jaycees. Her crowning

achievement was at the National Convention in June 2000, when she lead the delegation in the number two position in the Parade of States. She helped win national recognition for her efforts. Through her leadership and vision, the Florida Jaycees was recognized as the Most Outstanding State Award in area programming.

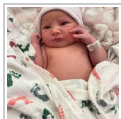
