



Mr. Lewis P. Moon Jr.

July 7, 1930 - November 8, 2018

Born in Philadelphia, Lewis was the son of Lewis P. and Margaret E. (Schoen) Moon. He began his educational career in the Upper Darby School system, then attended Bordentown Military Institute, Haverford School, and Lehigh University. He served his country in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict. While stationed at Fort Hood, TX, he met JoAnn, the love of his life. On Labor Day weekend 1952, his friend, Marv, set up a blind date. A year later JoAnn and Lewis became husband and wife. Following his military service, Lewis entered life as a businessman. He was owner and president of J.W. Moon, Inc. in Philadelphia, PA, Leiss Metal Products in Catasauqua, PA, and Moon-American in Easton, PA. He loved God, family, friends, and his work, often saying, "I never worked a day in my life." Many business acquaintances developed into life long family friends. After living in the Philadelphia Area (Havertown, Drexel Hill, and Rosemont, PA), Easton, PA, and Ocean City, NJ, he and JoAnn retired to Cocoa Beach Florida where, "The sun is shining, people are on the beach and in the water," became his mantra whenever he had a telephone conversation with his daughters.

Lewis is survived by his loving wife of 65 years JoAnn (nee Gidley) Moon; daughters Linda (Mark) Atwood of Nazareth, PA, Barbara Moon and Deborah (Wayne) Smith of Cape Canaveral, FL, H. Elizabeth (Vincent) Coladonto of Downingtown, PA, and Cynthia (Byron) Thornton of McKinney, TX; Nephew Gregory Kenrick; Niece Suzanne Aloia; Grandchildren Farrell Hendrickson,

Paul Moore, Christopher Coladonato, Eric Moore, Harrison Klein, Fredrick Klein, Marie Coladnato, Kyle Zimmerman, and Evan Klein; and Great Grandchildren Tyler and Caleb Moore. Lewis was predeceased by his parents and sister, Margaret "Polly" Kenrick.

Interment will be on Friday November 23 at the Cape Canaveral National Cemetery. Lewis's interment will be followed by a celebration of his life here on earth and with God in heaven.
