Norman "Longball" Boyd Crawford, 85, of Merritt Island passed away July 25, 2022 in Rockledge, Florida surrounded by family.

Norman was born November 25, 1936 in Butler, Pennsylvania. He joined the United States Air Force 02-01-1955 and was honorably discharged 12-18-1958 as an Airman 1st Class.

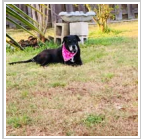
