Reno Mancini, age 80, passed away peacefully at his home on December 30th 2016 surrounded by his loving family.

Reno was born in Steubenville, OH on October 9th 1936, third child and only son of Elena (Basti) and Ernesto Mancini.

He moved to New Jersey with his family at the age of 12 and graduated in 1954 from Lodi High School. He served in the U.S. Army as an Italian Interpreter from 1958 to 1961 and was Honorably Discharged in 1964. He graduated from Ramapo College in 1971 with his B.A..

Reno worked as a Computer Engineer for IEC at Offutt Air Force Base in Omaha, Nebraska and Hoffmann-Laroche Pharmaceuticals before joining Martin-Marietta Space Shuttle Operations at Kennedy Space Center, Merritt Island Florida. He retired from Martin Marietta in 1999.

Reno was predeceased by his son Damon Mancini, daughter Dawn Mancini-Stevens and sister Anna Hawkes. He is survived by his loving wife of 52 years Susan, Son Darren Mancini (Chrissy) of Cocoa, Son David (Teresa) of

Titusville, daughter in law Tina (Damon) of Georgia, Sister Serafina Maciag of New Jersey.

His grandchildren Larry, Ashley, Brianna, Maya, Madison, Makenna, Julia, Sarah, Hayley and Leslie (Corey) Koonce. Great Grandchildren Colton and Jase Koonce.

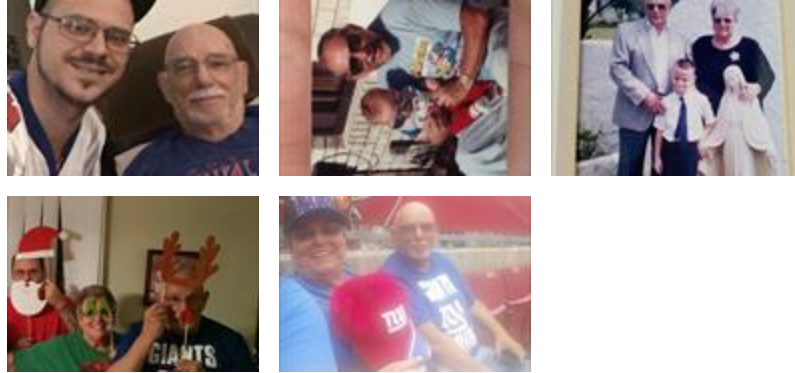

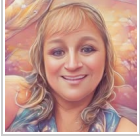

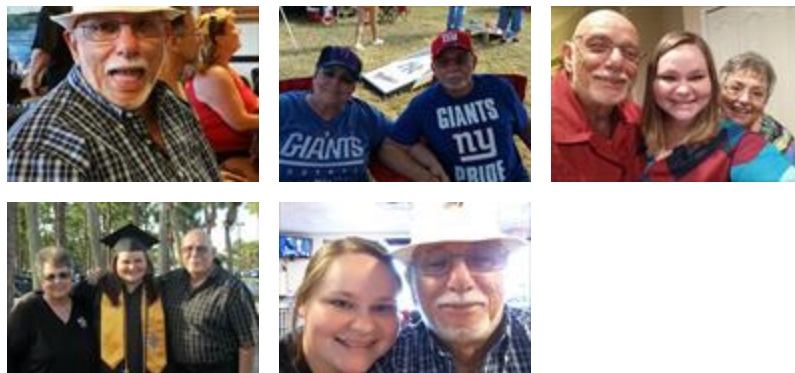
