



Mr. Robert Casavant

April 13, 1926 - January 16, 2018

Robert S. Casavant, 91, of Port St. John, passed away peacefully on January 16, 2018 at the Hospice of St. Francis Care Center in Titusville, FL with his family by his side.

Bob was born in Southbridge, Massachusetts on April 13, 1926. He was a WWII vet who entered into the Navy Pre-Flight school in 1944 to train as a pilot. When the war ended in 1946, he was discharged. After the Navy he pursued his love of electronics by attending several schools, eventually graduating from Capitol Radio Electronics School in Washington DC and later with a BSEE from F.I.T. in Melbourne, FL.

Bob started his professional career working for Engineering and Research Corp (ERCO) in Panama City Florida 1954. In 1957 accepted a job with Martin Corp in Orlando, FL. In 1959 he was offered a Senior Engineering position with Lockheed Missiles and Space Co. (LMSC), to support one of the early missile/satellite test programs at Cape Canaveral Air Force Station. He spent most of his remaining working career with LMSC, finally retiring in 1985.

Bob is survived by: the love of his life Cecelia his wife of 66 years, his daughters Karen Wilson (Billy) of Merritt Island and Cindy Casavant of Port St. John, his sons Roy Casavant (Michelle) of Port St. John, and John Casavant of Merritt Island. He was preceded in death by his son Steve Casavant. He

also has eight grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.
