



Mr. Roberto Reyes Casumbal

June 7, 1940 - September 7, 2017

Roberto Reyes Casumbal, 77 years old, passed away peacefully on September 7 on Merritt Island, Florida. Roberto was a gentle, loving, and hilarious man. He was born on June 7, 1940 to Apolinario and Gliceria (nee Reyes) Casumbal in Pasig, Rizal, Philippines, where he was raised. He was married to Carmelita (nee San Luis) on July 8, 1972 at St. Thomas Moore Cathedral in Arlington, VA. He attended Mapua Institute of Technology and National University in Manila. In the Philippines he was a building safety inspector for schools in Rizal. After migrating to the United States he became an architectural and structural drafter. He helped design the architectural plans for the rebuilt Henlopen Hotel, the first and oldest hotel in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware. He worked as a drafter for Washington Gas Light in Springfield, VA for 32 years.
