Ronnie Lawson passed away Sunday, January 21, 2018 at the age of 46. Ronnie was born in Lexington, KY to parents Patricia (Petey) McCain and Melvin Lawson on August 12, 1971. Although a native of Kentucky he made Brevard County his home in 1988. A Celebration of Life Service for Ronnie will be 5pm on Monday, January 29 at the Cocoa Elks Club at 315 Florida Ave for all family and friends.

Ronnie is survived by his daughter, Hailey Lawson, his mother, Patricia McCain, his brother Michael Lawson, and his half brother Chris Lawson. He was preceded in death by his father, Melvin Lawson.

As his daughter, Hailey, nephew, Garret, and niece, Casey, remembered him they agreed he "always smelled good." His daughter Hailey remembered he enjoyed going out and having fun - to the beach, to the movies, or going out to eat. And he liked his music. If riding in the car with Ronnie the person could expect to listen to Ronnie's favorite Rap and Hip Hop music. And they all agreed he was the original "Mr. Clean" as he wanted everything to be kept spotless. Ronnie was nicknamed "Baked Beans" as a child and this nickname continued into adulthood.

Ronnie will be forever loved and missed by his family and friends.
