Tere was the type of person to go out of the way and do anything for anyone. She always kept her promises and always had a beautiful smile that radiated to others. She touched so many people's lives and left a mark on this Earth that will never fade. She was married for 10 years and had her daughter at 37 years old. Her daughter was her favorite thing in this world. Tere taught her daughter so many amazing skills and gave her the best qualities of love, compassion, sharing, and empathy. Tere always use to say "Keep Smiling." Everyone please remember that she is with you in your heart always and in her words "no matter what it will be, everything will be ok." She passed away due to Stage 4 Lung Cancer that spread to her brain and liver. She gave it a good fight by doing two weeks of radiation on her brain, which she completed. Her daughter took care of her for 3 weeks before she passed in her daughter's home. The days before she passed she was at peace and had no regrets in life. She retired 7 years early, got to travel to places with life long friends, enjoyed spending time with her brother and sister, spent time with her daughter walking 4 dogs, loved watching the full moon come up once a month with friends, and got to spend time with her step son's children. Whenever you see a full moon think of her as she loved the beauty of it. Tere got to spend a full life of ups and downs and mostly blessings. She was so wise and never judged anyone. She will be greatly missed and always loved.
