



Mr. Valentin Victor Stanton

February 4, 1930 - September 10, 2024

A tremendously kind, true gentle man with a witty, dry sense of humor and an extremely intelligent man of endless knowledge, it is with great sadness to share that Valentin Victor “Uncle Val” Stanton (Stanculeescu), 94 years young, Miami/Merritt Island, Florida, passed away on September 10, 2024. Born in Timișoara, Romania, he was educated there as a Chemist. Becoming a U.S. Citizen and living in Miami in the 50’s, he worked his way up to a degree as Master of Science and was employed as a Computer Scientist at the University of Miami. He was an aspiring (and should have been famous) artist later in life with his wife Liana, focusing on realistic oil paintings of portraits, architecture, and nature. William Bouguereau was his favorite Classical Traditional artist. Uncle Val had a deep love and admiration for animals; wild and domestic. If he could’ve saved all the abuse in the animal kingdom, he would have done so. He cherished classical music, operas, fine art shows, gardening, orchids, shirts with a pocket, the cosmos, politics, math, cloud formations, Borjomi sparking water, eating healthy, creative cooking, exploring the universe, and doting on his rescued kitties. He was an avid reader and collector of books. Uncle Val had no children and was preceded in death by his wife Liana.
